Twelve years ago **The Dublin Singers** was founded as a true community chorus with a goal of enriching Dublin and the surrounding Columbus area by sharing the vocal talents of adults who love to sing. Over the past decade **The Dublin Singers** have had the opportunity to perform for hundreds of patrons through numerous concerts and shows including the Dublin Irish Festival, Dublin's Holly Days Celebration, the Ohio State Fair and Carnegie Hall in New York City.
